The play looks back at the reclusive playwright's life and her struggle with the imaginary demons that tormented her, such as the characters from Charlotte Bronte's *Jane Eyre*. This compelling drama interweaves with the storyline of *Jane Eyre* and, in particular, the character of Bertha Mason (the first Mrs Rochester) who is the madwoman locked in the attic. Rhys's obsession with her alter ego, Bertha, became the catalyst for *The Wide Sargasso Sea*.

The novel *The Wide Sargasso Sea* was adapted in 2006 for BBC television and starred Rebecca Hall as Bertha and Rafe Spall as Mr Rochester.
